

Appeal after report of assault and criminal damage

Officers are investigating a report of assault and criminal damage which is reported to have happened over the weekend.

Shortly before 1.50pm on Saturday (24 November), a woman contacted police about an assault which is alleged to have happened in a field off Saddington Road in Mowsley.

Officers attended shortly after the report but were unable to locate the woman as she had left the scene. Further attempts were made to meet her at an agreed location.

That afternoon the same woman made an additional call to police to report that her car windscreen had been smashed in Theddingworth.

An investigating officer has been assigned to both reports and enquiries are ongoing. Officers are also aware of an image circulating on social media which is alleged to have been taken around the time the car windscreen was damaged.

Anyone who witnessed either the alleged assault or criminal damage, or who has footage of either incident, is asked to call PC Daryl Sturgess on 101, quoting incident number 326 of 24 November so the information can be properly recorded by police.
