Shearsby Parish Development Plan

Group 4 is focussing on the needs of the business community, in and around the Parish of Shearsby. So as a starting point we collected information and views through the questionnaire

18 Questionnaires were sent out to local businesses with 11 Returned
Not all the Majority and Minority answers add up to 11 as some questions could have more than one answer from an individual and some questions were not all answered

Q A1 Majority in favour of new and existing business working from home or small premises i.e. Financial and Professional services, Hospitality, Tourism, Leisure and crafts and Agriculture related services

Majority Discouraged Transport, Storage and Distribution.

Q A2 Majority of 6 to 4 in Favour of making more land available with 1 don't know

Q A3 Majority of 18 in favour of using a combination of Existing Buildings Inc. Redundant Farm Buildings. Minority of 8 wanted to use Brown and Green field land

Q A4 Majority of 6 in Favour of using land along Saddington Road. The others were 3 Along Bruntingthorpe Rd. 2 along A5199 between Shearsby and Arnesby 1 Within the village and 1 nowhere

Q A5 Majority of 8 to 3 not wanting Housing and Industrial buildings mixed.

Q A6 Majority of 7 to 3 to encourage new businesses

Q A7 Those that answered Question A6. The Majority want Faster Broadband new houses and purpose built businesses premises. A minority of 2 required better roads

Q A8 Majority of 7 to 2 with 2 don't know, want to protect employment sites from change of use

Q A9 Encourage small Businesses

Q B1 Majority of 8 to 3 says roads not adequate to sustain future developments

Q B2 Majority Of 7 to 3 state Public transport not required. Minority say buses to Fosse Park and Mkt Harboro needed.

Q B3 Majority of 9 to 2 state parking Adequate. Those that say more parking required say the best place would be hard standing on Mill lane.

Q C1 Faster Broadband is the Majority. With other suggestions of new houses, more police more work. Hotel rooms and a camp site

Q C2 One Response requested Agricultural ties on property lifted

Q C3 Two responses, one required more covered space and one required a camp site in next 15 years

Q D1 Majority of 5 replies came from Agriculture, forestry and Fishing The other Replies equally divided from the list with no replies from Energy and Water Manufacture, Finance and Insurance, Real estate, Admin and Support and Arts Entertainment and Recreation.

Q D2 Majority all wants No Large Developments, only Individual Houses and No Large Industrial Units.
