**VASL ( Voluntary Action South Leicester )**

VASL is a charity based at Torch House, Northampton Road Market Harborough.  
What are we all about.....**Support the isolated**.....over 60. feel part of the community, make new friends, get online or out and about.  
**Support unpaid carers**  
**Help young carers**.....making sure they have time to enjoy themselves as well as benefit from our support.  
**Provide a social car scheme.**  
**We are desperately short of voluntary drivers** to convey persons who without the service cannot easily get to health visits, social appointments etc.  
From the Market Harborough office **we are doing on average 90 journeys a week, and are 20 drivers short.** We use our own vehicles and get a mileage allowance. It is up to the volunteer to name the days they are available, and whether they would just like short runs or longer ones to hospital. We wait no longer than 2 hours so you are not going to sit for many hours waiting. Most appointments are only on average 1 hour long. Volunteer drivers have free parking spaces to use.  
I am one of the volunteer drivers and have also been tasked to recruit more. I am contacting local groups and getting myself invited to the meetings to give short talks of up to 10 minutes to get the word out there and then I leave. So far I have visited WI's, U3A's, Rotary, Garden Clubs etc.
