Bob's Reflections on Rehab at Flint House Police Rehabilitation Centre, Goring on Thames.

Following a period of treatment for Bladder Cancer resulting in extreme weakness, it was suggested by the Police Welfare Committee that I would benefit from a short stay at 'Flint' which is a centre dealing with injured officers both physically and mental, to which a retired officer may attend spaces allowing.

I arrived on Sunday 16th June to be met by Nursing Staff and a personal Physio called Hannah along with Nathan my rehab trainer. I lovingly called them the laughing assassins who put me through my paces for 5 days.

Throughout my stay nothing was to much trouble, and when thanks were offered 'That's what we are here for' was the given reply, but what was on offer was over and above the expected. There was an atmosphere of care not only by the staff but the officers attending, we were able to share and encourage each other over coffee knowing we could trust each other who were almost strangers. Some of the guys and girls had been present at scenes we would shudder at and they knew they would have to return back to similar situations when back at work. There were others who were so injured they would never be able to carry out duties again.

There were all faiths there but what was important was the commitment one to another which wasn't prescribed but natural. Oh for the Christian faith to reflect such concern and extra mile attitude.

Please pray for the Emergency Services as they carry out their duties to ensure our safety.
