



Cobblestone Cottage (above) is one of the many quaint old dwellings that give Shearsby its characteristic flavour. The church tower is dated 1789, and was left incomplete a few feet above the parapet where it turned octagonal. The rest of the church is externally new, and was considerably heightened by Ordish when he restored it. The only original features, according to Pevsner, are the sedilia and piscina.
