

Cyclist seriously injured after being involved in collision with two cars in Welford Road, Shearsby

A cyclist has been taken to hospital with serious injuries after he was involved in a collision with two cars.

The rider was injured in Welford Road, Shearsby, near Market Harborough, last night.

[Leicestershire Police](#) said he had been in a collision with two cars, a Silver Vauxhall Corsa and Black Ford Fiesta.

The occupants of the vehicles were not injured.

Police have appealed to witnesses to come forward to help detectives establish the circumstances of the collision, which happened at the junction of Bruntingthorpe Road and Saddington Road shortly after 7.30pm.

In a statement, the force said: "The cyclist sustained serious injuries and was taken to University Hospitals of Coventry and Warwickshire where he remains in a stable condition.

"Officers investigating the collision would like to speak to anyone who may have witnessed the incident or saw any of the vehicles beforehand."
