

# Man dies in 3-vehicle crash in rural Leicestershire

He was pronounced dead at the scene

A man has died after three vehicles collided in rural Leicestershire this afternoon.

The crash involved a BMW, a car transporter and a Ford Fiesta.

The driver of the BMW was pronounced dead at the scene of the incident, in Bruntingthorpe Road, near Lutterworth, in the south of the county. No information about the man has been released.

The driver of the car transporter was taken to hospital in Coventry with minor injuries.

The Fiesta driver escaped the smash uninjured.

[Leicestershire Police](#) is appealing for witnesses to the fatal incident, which occurred at about around 4.45pm.

Detective Constable John Borlase, who is the investigating officer, said: "The cars were travelling towards the A5199 from Bruntingthorpe Road and the transporter lorry was driving in the opposite direction when the collision occurred.

"I would like to hear from anyone who was in the vicinity and saw the vehicles being driven beforehand, or the collision itself.

“Equally, if you have dashcam footage capturing what happened, I would urge you to contact us.”

[Bruntingthorpe Road](#) is closed from the junctions of Mill Lane and the A5199.

The road is expected to remain closed for around six hours to allow for an investigation of the scene, and for recovery of the vehicles.

Motorists are advised to seek an alternative route.

East Midlands Ambulance Service, Helimed and Leicestershire Fire and Rescue Service were also in attendance this afternoon.
