

## SHEARSBY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

### GROUP 2 LAND USE

#### Minutes of the meeting held on Thursday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2015 at Elmsbrook, Fenny Lane.

Persons present: Jane, Mavis, David.

1. Mavis presented a list of persons who own land within the parish, complete with addresses, which now total 25.
2. To date, the letter and map of the parish fields has been sent out to 23 land owners, asking each to identify his land and give details of its use. At this time 9 replies have been received. Jane arranged to obtain a large map of the parish for all information to be collated.
3. It was suggested that a letter was also sent to Mr Neville Hall, as it was undecided as to whether he still owned a small area within the parish.
4. The Meeting then discussed the need to identify green areas, woodland areas and sights of interest for nature conservation within the parish, for potential protection.
5. The Meeting identified the following:-  
The Village Green which belongs to the people of Shearsby in perpetuity.  
Welford Road Bank (adjacent to The Butterpot).  
The Verge by Welford Road bungalows.  
The field at the top of Fenny Lane which has two footpaths and the adjoining stream/wooded area known as Bears' Hole which belongs to Richard Whitting, Steve Anstey and Co.  
The Spinney in Second Close which has beehives and belongs to Thorpehill Farm.  
The Spinney belonging to Thorpehill Farm which was laid out by the Woodland Trust and which belongs to Thorpehill Farm, and which is filled with snowdrops in winter.  
The footpath and surrounding area which was cut off when the bend on the old A 50 was improved.
6. For this plan to be formulated it is essential that all members of the community are contacted and their comments taken into consideration. Thus it was agreed that a letter be sent out to each household, asking for opinions on the sites and for other sites to be suggested. This will be circulated in the next few weeks.

The next meeting is to be held at Elmsbrook on Thursday August 13<sup>th</sup> 2015 at 10.30am.

The meeting closed at 12.00noon.
